I am writing to oppose the planning of New College Cross.

The main reason for opposing the planning is due to 'weak foundations incapable of supporting the additional two floors'. Attachment evidences that previously its has been told the building is not strong enough.

Noise pollution from drilling/machines. Working overhead would severely increase the noise. Loss of all light due to scaffolding/trucks/building work. One whole wall of my property is windows so I would loose all light, and would have sever visual pollution from scaffolding.
