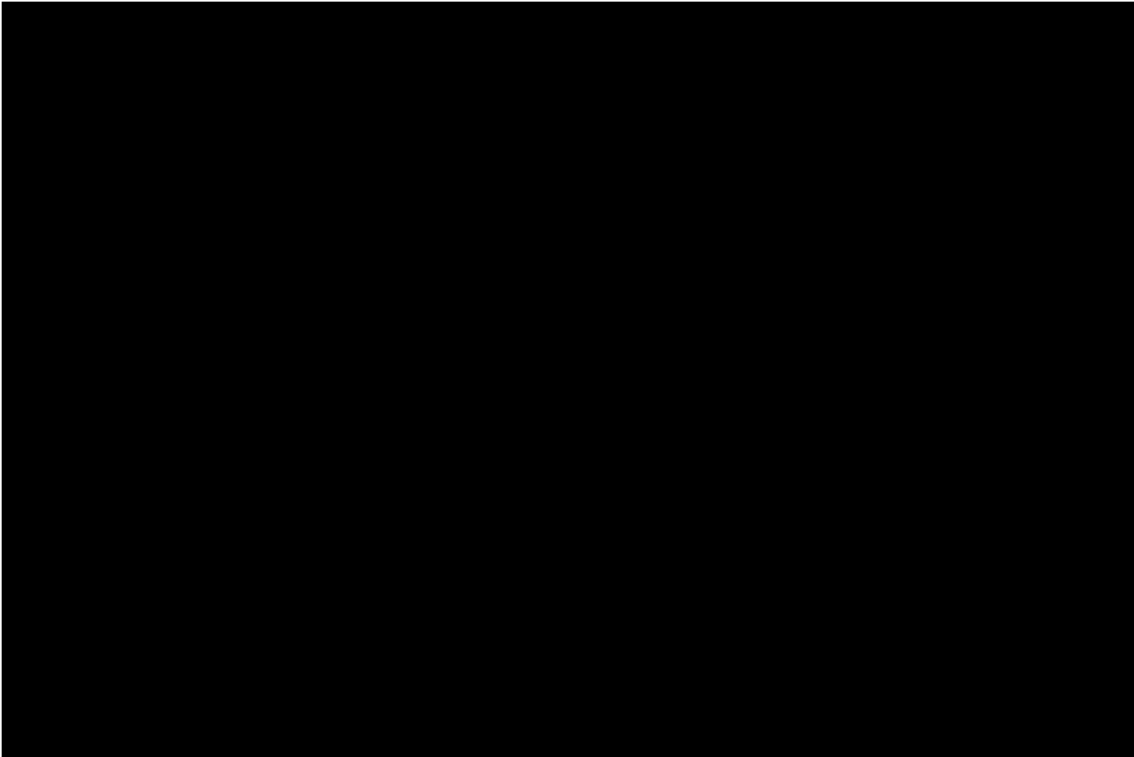
My name is Lorraine Omari-Asor and am I writing to show my support for the joint development scheme that has been drawn up for the church.

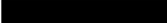

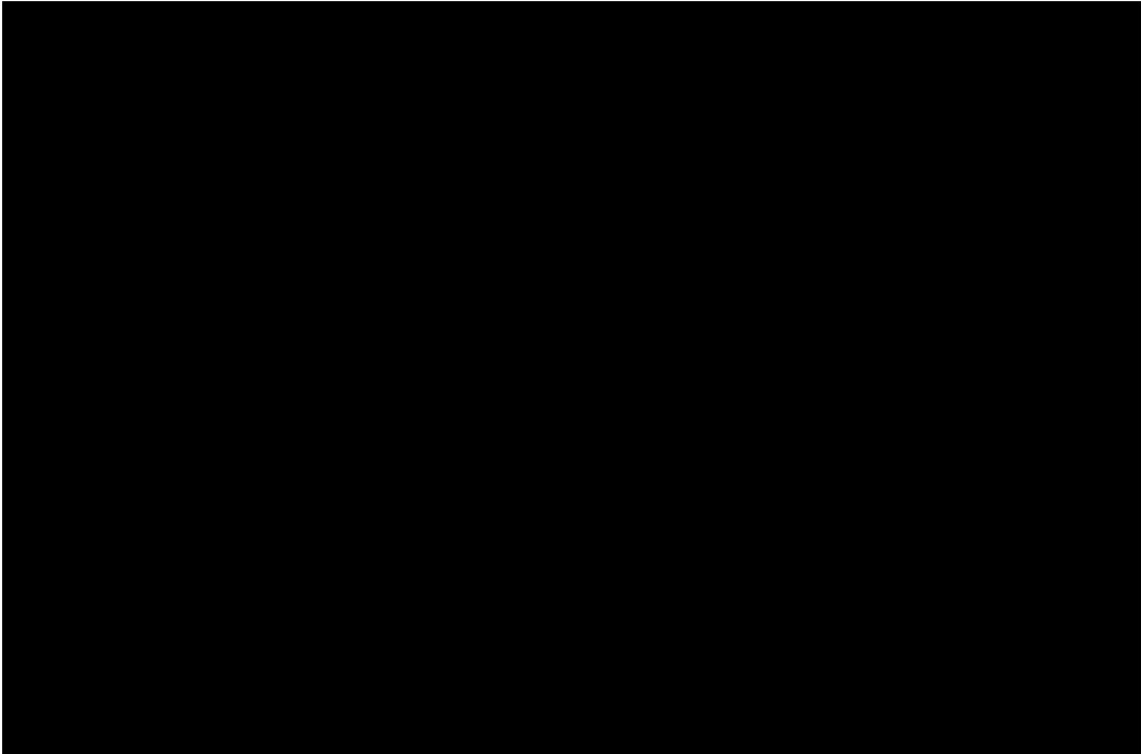
Please take this email as confirmation that I am agreeable for the works to go ahead and do not object to the use of a 'bed and breakfast' within the facility.

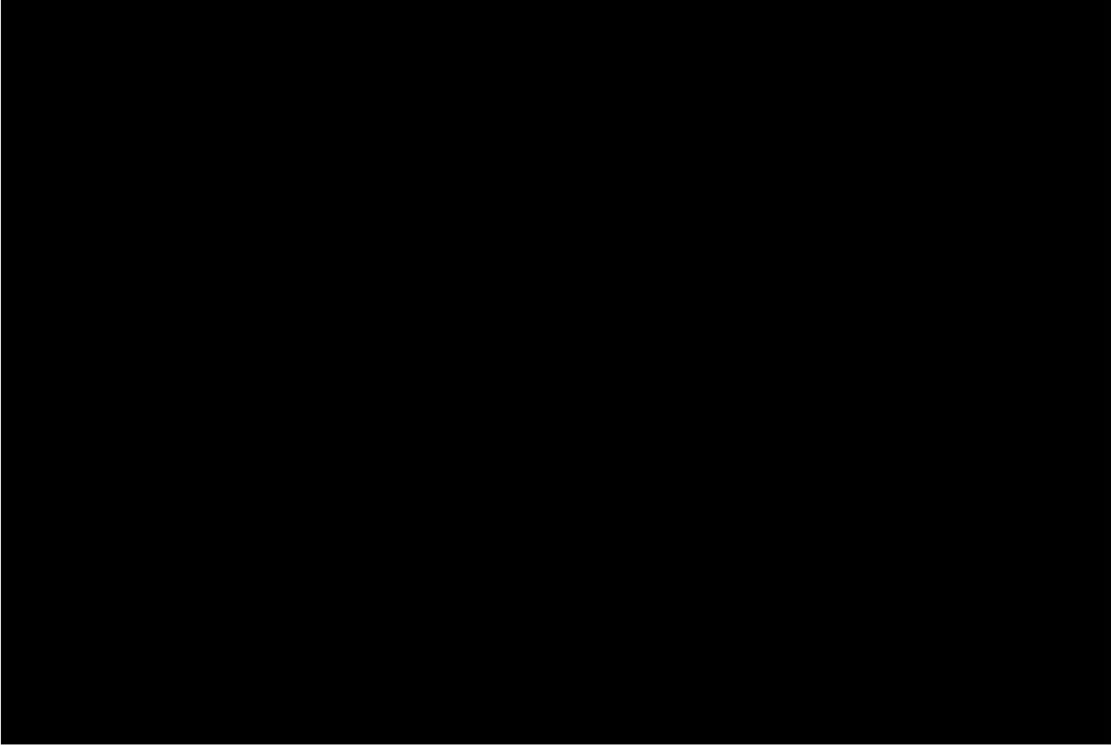




Dear Case Officer,
