I live almost opposite 12 Leverton St and I object to the proposed removal of the fireplace and replacement with a Regency style fireplace. In the application it is stated that this fireplace is reproduction. This is not true. The fireplace is original as I can see from the photograph. It is exactly the same as the one in my house which is also original. The photograph is dark so I can only just see the "inside" of the fireplace, but that also looks original. In this Grade 2 listed house the removal of this now rare fireplace would be completely contrary to its listing. These houses were built as cottages and the fireplaces are cottage-type, as is my front door which is original.

Please refuse this part of the application – the removal of an original fireplace to be replaced by a reproduction.
