Very steep viewing angle & configuration of the internal plan prevent overlooking & loss of privacy between the proposed rooflights to 15a & the adjacent side windows to 14 Parliament Hill & to the top floor flat of 15 Parliament Hill.

Roof ridge raised by 145 mm & internal floor levels adjusted to lessen excavation & improve the relationship between the ground floor & garden. Roof form simplified.

Roofs generally clad in flat, horizontally welled, pre-weathered, natural, grey zinc (instead of a mixture of zinc & clay tile). Zinc throughout is a more singular & practical solution to the variable roof forms. The grey tone matches adjacent slate roofs & visually blends with the surrounding context.

Attic level window repositioned more centrally & at higher level to improve ventilation & simplify roof profile & structure.

Roof ridge raised by 255 mm & internal floor levels adjusted to lessen excavation & improve the relationship between the ground floor & garden.
