It is a beautiful tree and greatly enhances our outlook. If it was felled it would expose a large, bare flank wall and also other houses along Stratford Villas. We believe that the reason to fell the tree is that it is leaning on a trellis and that the trellis will need to be rebuilt. Why therefore, cannot the trellis be rebuilt 1-2 feet further away and the tree be left intact? We need to preserve mature trees, especially in a conservation area and they can also have an impact on water levels below ground. We heard that Silver Birch trees have a short life, but according to a rhs website this is about 80 years. Bearing this in mind, this very healthy looking tree has many years left. For these reasons we are strongly opposed to this application.
