Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed rear dormer and inset roof terrace by reason of its bulk, detailed design and materials would be harmful to the character and appearance of the host building and the largely unaltered roof profile of Dennington Park Road, contrary to CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 (Securing high quality design) of the London Borough of Camden Local



Development Framework Development Policies and A14 of the Fortune Green and West Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan 2014.
