Dear Zenab, I believe that this continued re-application from Turley on behalf of Essential Living for the demolition of 100 Ave road now amounts to harassment. I strongly object to any changes to the original agreed arrangement that specific worked take place BEFORE demolition. I trust that Camden will uphold their commitment on this matter especially as there is an current legal matter to answer.

We who live on the periphery of The Green strongly object to Essential Living's determination to place commercial premises, retail, shops, cafes, restaurants facing our bedroom windows, a mere 75m away.

We further object to the Eton Rd tube exit/entrance being moved to be in line with the path at the rear of Hampstead theatre. This would direct people traffic, day and night ,to pass our bedroom windows.I wish to have the opportunity to discuss this plan with TfL.

This both of these plans, especially the change of tube exit/entrance is a gross affront to our right to peace and quiet in our own homes. In fact it amounts to an abuse of our human rights. Should these plans go ahead, the retail and the tube exit/entrance change let it be known to Essential Living that **we intend (even after the constuction) to continue our campaign** to let it be known that our lives are seriously impaired by this development. We will not sit in silence at such an affront to our lives here.

I request a meeting with LfT on this matter.
