South-West



Roof cornice repainted, and flashing removed and planted behind parapet.

Roof plane used for solar panels.
Cast iron drainage pipe adjacent to existing.

Palm House extension inspired by the areas historic nurseries, with steel framed glazing derived from the house's picture window from the street elevation. A curved glass roof echoes the arched windows of the area both next door, along the street and at the rear on Murray Mews.

Garden level lowered to original.

New iron railing installed.


Quoin stones reinstated around entrance.

Drainage design consolidated and replaced with cast iron work.

Quoin stones reinstated at side of house.

Steel reinforced timber gate, with glazed Log and Refuse Store roof, set beneath chimney breast.

Reclaimed and matching brick extension, set back from house.
