Where and when do I put out my rubbish and recycling?

On the morning of your collection day please make sure your rubbish and/or recycling is outside your property where it can be easily seen before 7am. You can put it out the night before.

Please note that times of collection may vary and collection days may change during Bank Holiday periods.

Please do not put recycling or garden waste in black bin bags, even if it is then placed in a recycling container, as our drivers cannot easily see the contents and will assume it is household rubbish.
