Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Chestnut (approx 21m) - reduce or remove one major limb to reduce potential hazard and risk of limb drop or tear out, raise remaining crown by 3-3.50m to balance, reduce back branches growing towards house by approximately 20% to give a minimum clearance of 1.50-2.00m and thin crown density throughout by 20%.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 20 February 2016 and does not wish to object.

Informative(s):

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by



the Council.

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
