The submitted details of the 1.8m high privacy screen to north side of the roof terrace are considered acceptable and to meet the requirements of condition 4. The timber materials are sympathetic to the area and provide the opaque screening of the correct height as required by the condition.

The proposed development is in general accordance with the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, with particular regard to policies CS14 and CS15 and the London Borough of Camden Local Development
