We oppose this application, on these grounds:

1. The Basement Impact Assessment, although comprehensive, does not explicitly assess the extent of potential damage to adjacent properties, by reference to the Burland Scale of damage. The purpose of BIA's is to provide security for adjacent property owners in the face of basement excavations and construction, in the public interest.

2. The design of the rear extension is out of character with the house, or the Conservation Area generally. In particular, the materials proposed for the facetted extension are not specified. (the DAS refers to "a complimentary material"; what can this mean?)
