Regarding a young Quercus llex that is causing structural damage to the garden wall at Grove End and is very likely to push the wall onto the public footpath if allowed to get any bigger.

We (the residents and freeholders of Grove End House) would like to apply to remove the tree and replace it with a Magnolia or Japanese Maple the scale of which will be more in keeping with the rest of the mature and cared for garden and will also match other gardens along Grove Terrace. I have contacted Eileen Wilson who has advised us and agreed to support the case for removing the Quercus Ilex. Eileen said the following, 'Due to the huge Plane tree opposite, the high hedge and the evergreen next door, this tree is unable to reach its full potential growth and ideal shape. It is outcompeted for light. Maybe a lower colourful flowering shrub would be more suitable to replace it?' Thank you for your kind consideration.
