Your ref: 2016/2909/T - proposed tree work at 6 Netherhall Gardens, London NW3 5RR

Thank you for your notification concerning the proposed removal of two lime trees, stated as T9 and T11 on the related plan.

As your records will show, trees have already been removed from this site, notably ones from my own garden. I think it is thus especially important to preserve a tree wherever possible.

First of all, I think there may be an error in your plan which states that T9 is a lime tree. It isn't. Is this being confused with T10 which is a lime tree and, moreover, appears to grow more or less directly out of the foundations of the relevant property? Perhaps you could clarify this? Nonetheless, I would not object to T9 or T10 being removed, if absolutely necessary, given the proximity issue.

However, T11, which abuts my property and provides pleasant greenery and shade, is a considerable distance - no less than 9 metres - from the relevant property. <u>I would therefore like to object to this tree being removed</u>. Naturally, I would not oppose it being regularly pruned.
