1 Reasons for approving the details:



The submitted details of cycle and refuse storage are acceptable with the details being in accordance with the Council's standards. Three parking spaces have been provided as per the wording of condition 5. The spaces would be secure and located on the front garden at ground floor level for ease of access. The covered refuse storage bins would be located in the front garden set behind the front boundary wall, 20cm taller. The refuse and cycle storage would be visible from the highway but not to an extent to result in detrimental character impacts to the public realm.

The site's planning history has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with policies CS5 and CS11 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP17 and DP26 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
