I write to object to the planning application proposing the building of a roof terrace on the rear extension of number 14 Manley Street, NW1 8LT.

- 1. I live in small basement flat in the neighbouring house
- There is no daylight study with the application, but the extension will tower over our small back yard/ garden, which provides the only source of light to our living room and our bed room. We will lose most of our already limited amount of direct sunlight and will lose a significant amount of daylight, making our tiny yard/ garden seem like the bottom of a well.
- 3. From the proposed roof terrace it will be possible to look directly into our bedroom, from very close quarters. I estimate that people on the roof terrace will be about five or six meters from my bed. This will be both intimidating and embarrassing.
