
115-119 GOLDHURST TERRACE - A3 LANDSCAPE DESIGN PROPOSAL 22 JUNE 2016

DESIGN STATEMENT

Our design focuses on creating a beautiful soft landscaped environment whilst at the same time maximising usable outside space. Whenever settling in the garden, the inhabitant should feel enveloped by the soft landscape.

At both the front and back, an evergreen substructure of planting will provide year round interest and colour around which a palette of shade tolerant woodland edge planting will come and go with the seasons.





Indicative balcony treatment



Porcelain paving to be installed on pedestal system. Colour and variety TBC High quality clay, tall tapered pots 360 W x 1000 mm W. To be planted with Buxus balls

Powder coated trough planters 4300 L x 400 W x 600 mm H. Colour of the finish TBC

To be planted with loose evergreen hedge screening to a maximum overall height of 1800mm. One plant variety will be used for each balcony from the list below:

The alignment of trough planters may be altered on the upper balconies so that inhabitants may be better able to enjoy views afforded from those balconies.

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
