The Council's environmental health officer is satisfied that the supplied data is correct and therefore satisfies the requirements of condition 4 of planning permission 2016/0512//P so that noise emitted by standby or emergency



generators during power outages or testing does not exceed the lowest background noise levels. As such, it is considered the proposal satisfactorily demonstrates that the amenities of future occupiers are protected from noise nuisance.
