Reasons for objection:

- 1 The proposed works are considered not to be appropriate as the tree contributes considerable amenity to the area. The tree is highly viewable by neighbours as well as the general public along the canal. No evidence has been currently submitted to support the removal of the tree. The council would require evidence including an arboricultural report and engineering reports to consider the situation further.


