Objection to the planning application of 47 Doughty Street, WC1

Dear Ms Phillips,

In reference to the proposed alterations at 47 Doughty Street we strongly oppose this proposal as it will cause major problems for the Dickens Museum and all neighbours.

We live opposite The Dickens Museum and No. 47 and our objections are as follows:

1. The demolition of the existing rear extension interferes with the back extension of No 46, in fact they seemed to be linked
2. The tremors of the excavation will seriously damage surrounding structures as the houses are built on clay. We already experienced the

shaking of buildings in the street during a basement excavation at the corner of Doughty Mews

3. Building works to such an extent will cause a major disturbance in the street, expecting lorries and equipment to block at least one lane
4. This is a densely populated area with many families living in the street and any building work of that extent which includes demolition and excavation should not be allowed for health and safety reasons
