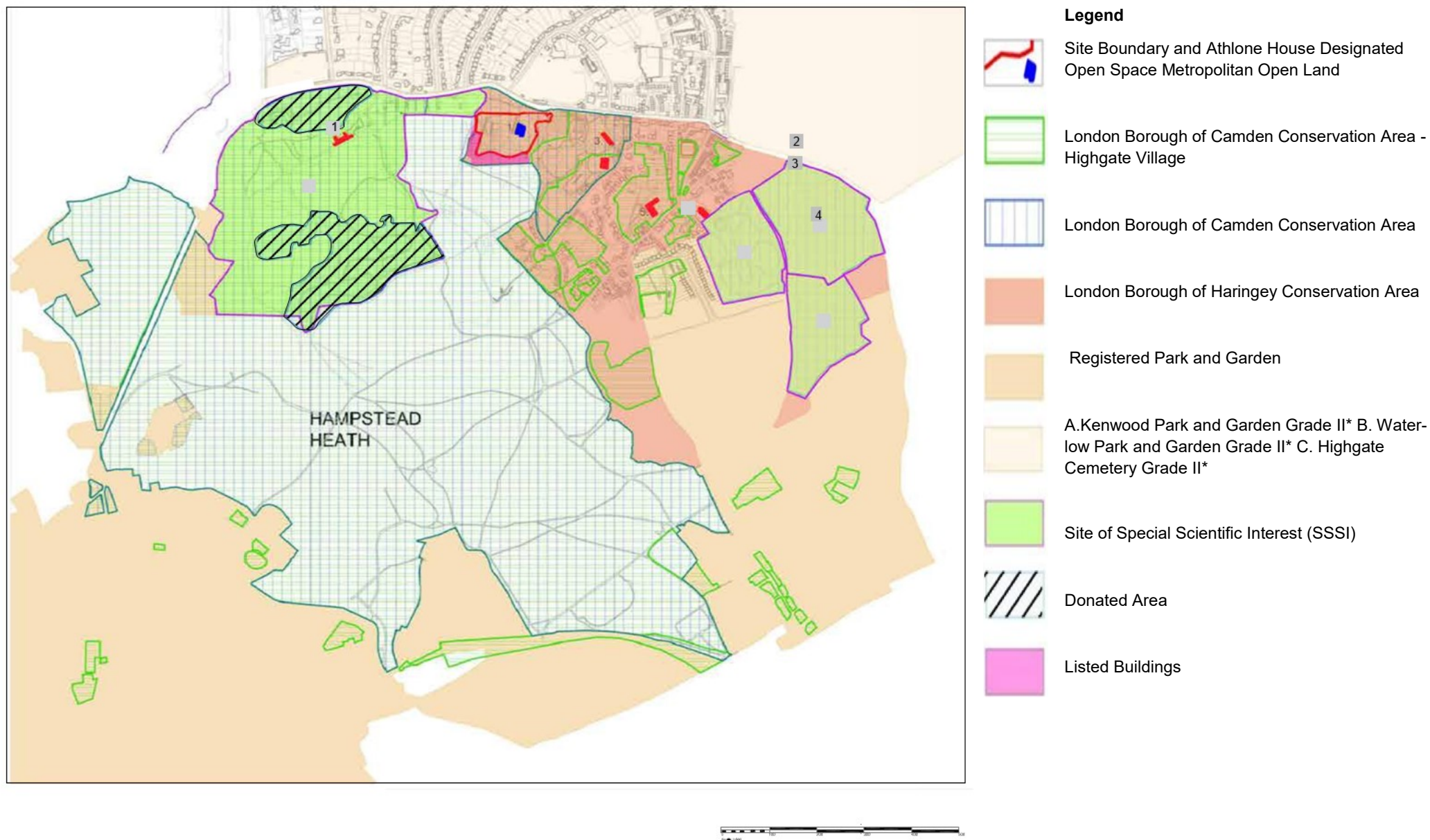


Figure 4: Designations



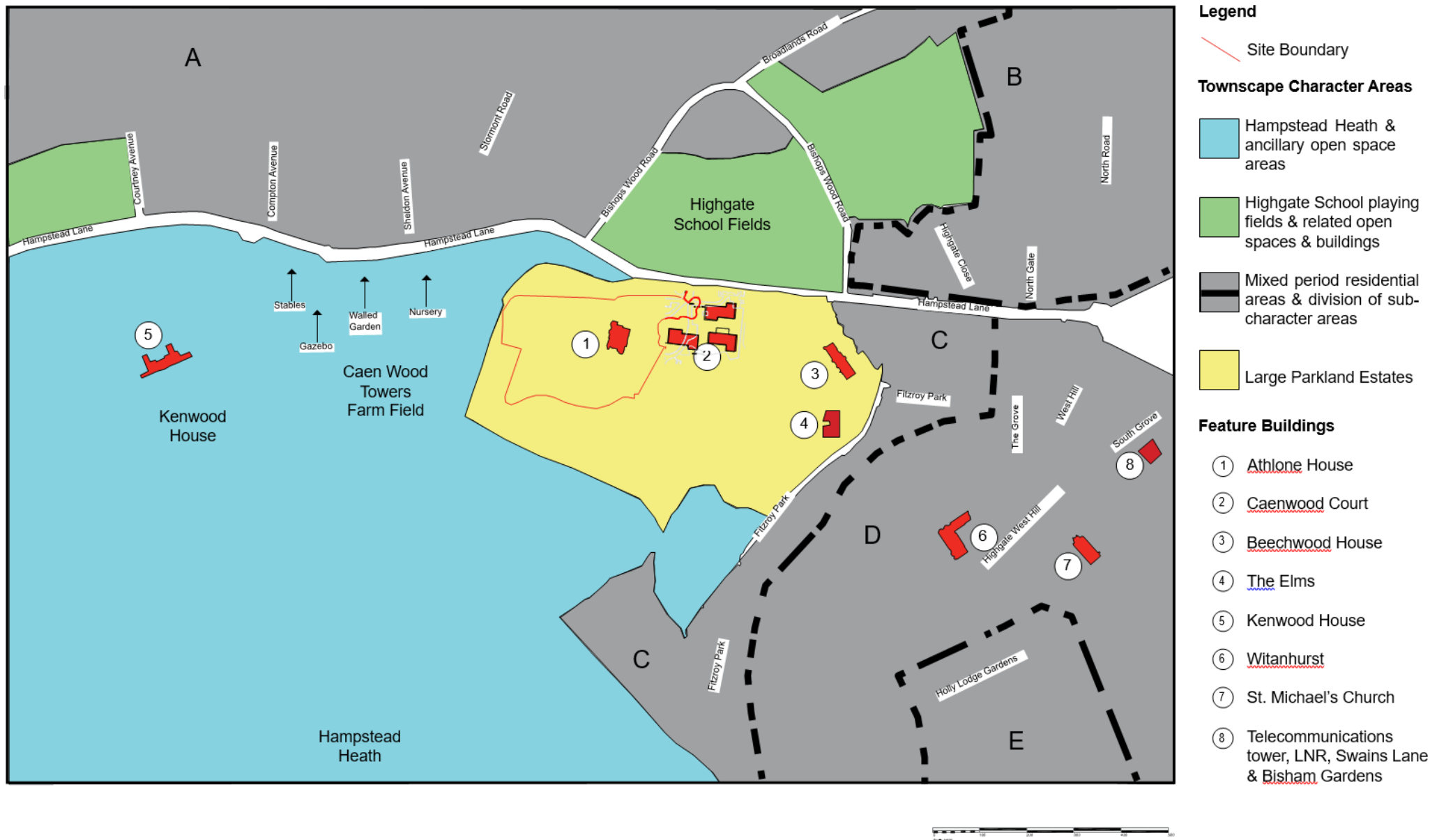


Figure 5: Townscape Character Areas



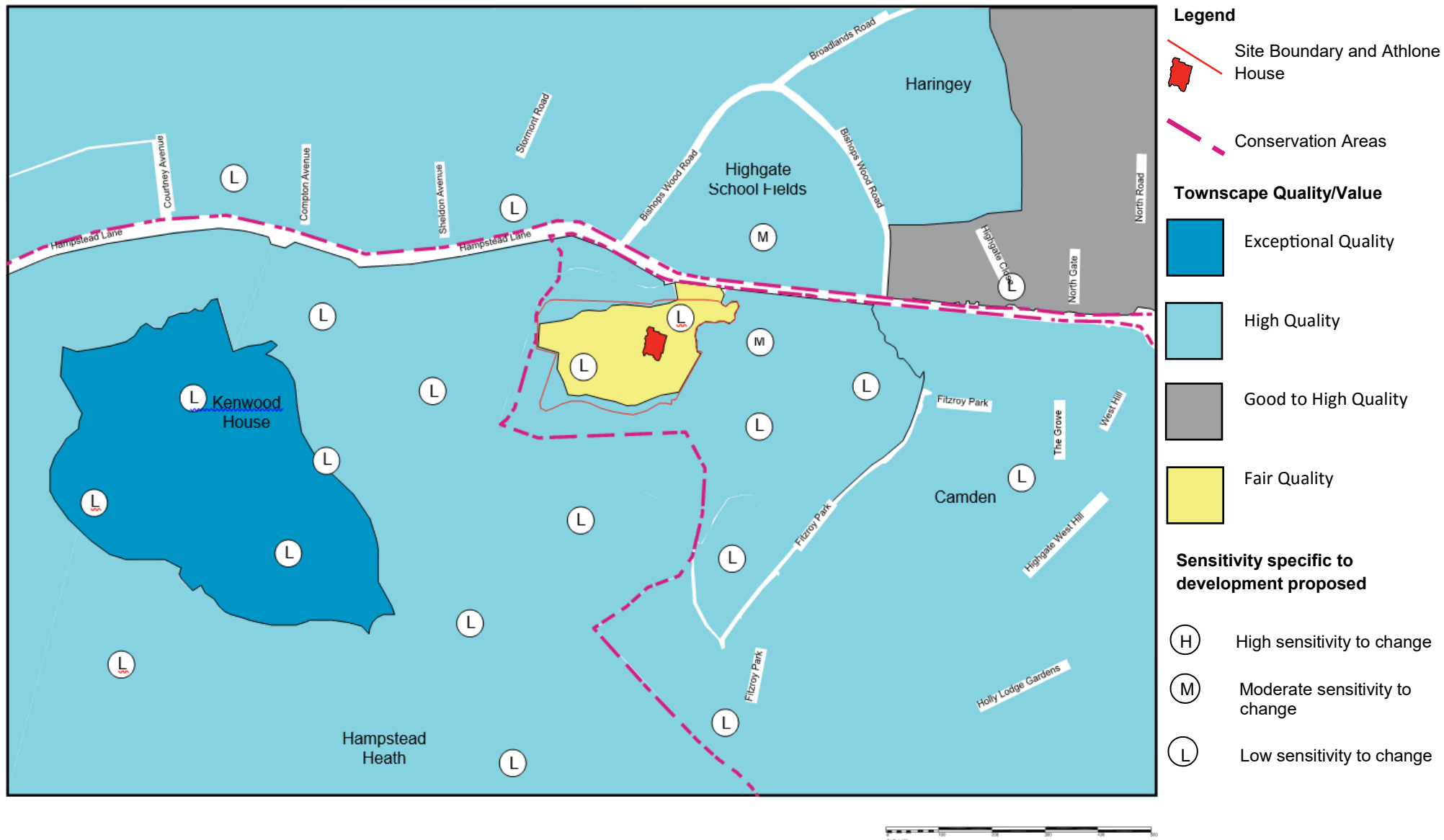


Figure 6: Townscape Quality & Sensitivity
