Hi Rob, my name is Jordan Laughlin. I work in sound post production as an engineer in London and am a London resident. Any work that is carried out to create a basement extension next to Air studios will disrupt their ability to record music and therefore operate as a business. Even the hint of this plan going ahead may mean they loose future bookings because productions can not risk their recording sessions being cancelled or sabotaged by building work.

Air Studios has been a pillar of excellence in music and music for film for decades now and will hopefully remain to do so.
