Fell to ground level; 1 x Cordaline (T5) - Fell  
1 x Ash tree (T6) - Crown Thin by 20%, dead wood  
1 x Oak Tree (T7) - Crown Thin by 20% and dead wood. Reduce laterals away from  
neighbours garden  
1 x Bay Tree - Crown Reduce by 3m and balance laterals - Remove epicormic in centre of  
crown

3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these




standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
