Dear Sir.

I am writing to object to the above planning application. The site is a fairground, and has not been in continuous use as a Caravan site for ten years.

There have been fairs and fairground rides, and a food stall on this site within the last ten years, particularly at the time of the other large fairs on the Heath (Easter & August Bank Holiday) and also on Summer Sundays throughout the years we have lived here (since March 1984).

The Abbott family are long-term residents, but the other Caravan owners come and go, I assume on short-term rental agreements.

The other point to make is that this site is designated as Metropolitan Open Land, and cannot be used for building.

To re-designate the site as a

caravan site would open the possibility of further development, to the detriment of the Heath, and the Vale of Health.
