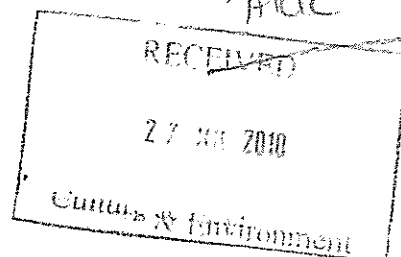

I am writing to strongly object to the above application. There should be no reason to allow change of use from a 'Showmans Site' to a 'Caravan Park'. This site is protected & zoned as Metropolitan Open Land & Private Open Space & that is un-changeable. It is also within a Conservation area & comes under the 'Finger of the Heath' policy. A very sensitive site indeed, which Camden must agree! This application is obviously a step toward another serious planning application similar to PWA 702255 which was absolutely rejected.

The Abbot Family have lived in one corner of this site over the last ten years. The rest of it has had transient inhabitants including a London Routemaster bus for a couple of years. It has also been used as a car park for builders vans ect. When the fair has come to the Upper Slopes of Hampstead Heath a childrens fair has been there. In the winter more fairground caravans appear to 'winter' here & when Spring comes they go back on the road again. The site as it looks today is very much clearer than usual! Up till very recently

There has always been lots of old fairground
'stuff' lying about waiting to be dealt with.
The Vale was over-developed by the Victorians!
It cannot deal with this site having loads
of caravans put on it. Issues such as
vehicular access + parking, water, electricity, noise
pollution ect would have to be addressed
very seriously should you be crazy enough
to grant a Certificate of Lawfulness!
