

2.0 Development Context











2.1 Site Location & Context

The site is located within Camden Stables Market. The site area is 116m2 and is adjacent to the Gin Building which itself is opposite the main Chalk Farm Road entrance.

Camden Stables Market forms an integral part of the larger Camden Market as one of five popular markets, including; the Lock Market, the Canal Market (Hawley Wharf – currently being redeveloped), Inverness Street and Union Street Market at Buck Street. The Electric Market, a weekend indoor market at the Electric Ballroom, was formerly the sixth area of the market but this has now closed.

Camden Stables Market lies within the Regent's Canal Conservation Area and contains the listed Grade II Horse Hospital Building and the listed complex of stabling buildings across the site. In addition the boundary wall running along Chalk Farm Road is also Grade II listed.

The Gin Building is not listed but is a building of historic interest, forming the end of a large terrace of buildings now demolished.

The site is well served by public transport including some 11 bus routes within a five minute walk. The site has a PTAL rating of 6a. The nearest underground station is Camden Town, approximately 450m to the south east and is served by the Northern Line. Camden Road Station, located approximately 500m east of the site, provides access to the London Overgound network.


Cycle parking facilities are located on a number of the side streets near the site, including Castlehaven Road opposite the site's eastern edge. A long stand of hire bikes is also located on Castlehaven Road within close proximity to the site.

2.2 Existing Character

Area Five contains one of the Stables Market's main entrances from Chalk Farm Road, and is a key public zone with a mix of small food and retail vendors.

The Gin House establishes a prominent and highly visible historic facade amongst more recent additions of timber and steel framed stalls. Currently, the building operates as the main entrance to Cyberdog, with its offices occupying the upper floors.
