T1, Magnolia, light prune to shape, needs slight reduction as too big for surroundings (1 metre height reduction, 1 meter lateral reduction) T2+3, Fig trees, remove to ground and grind stumps. trees have become too big, growing too close to windows and both lean by 35%, potentially unsafe over time.

T4, conifer hedge, around 30 trees on the street boundary, both sides of driveway. trees to be removed to ground and grind stumps. trees are dated and are no longer necessary as screening, trees will not be inkeeping with new garden and house design.

back garden.

T5 oak, tree is in good condition, just need to lift the crown by 1 mtrs as branches are growing quite low over side passage.

T6 Sycamore, again, tree is in good condition, crown to be lifted by 1.5 mtrs as over hanging side passage

T7-8 lime trees, trees are in neighbours garden (no 10) on the boundary. lower lateral branches to be removed on clients side, a crown lift of 1.5 mtrs.

7. Identification Of Tree(s) And Description Of Works

T9 Bay. multi stem bay tree to be removed to ground and grind stump. this tree is far too large for the space it is in and vastly reduces natural light coming into the garden. if removal is not an option, a reduction of 60% of the crown would be acceptable.
