There is an increase of 4 units and quite an increase in the amount of beds. There are presently 6 units allowed parking, therefore, there should not be a decreased amount of permits allowed for the property in section 106 agreement, then there should at least be no more granted to the address. The configuration of the number of single and double bedroom units should meet the needs of the borough by assessing the stock already available and already permitted. Therefore the number of these units should be in check with that stock, and if necessary, the number of 3 & 4 bedroom units should replace those. The design itself is unlike anything on the street. The compatibles are not in the same local area, and the front of the structure, roof, and Windows should reflect the streetscape that already exists along the two sides of the subject street.
