<u>Rea</u>	<u>ar right side</u> English Oak	(Quercus robur)	Reduce and reshape crown by up to 25-30% all round to suitable new growing points. Clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches, lift and balance crown
			Medium mature tree. To contain spread, improve light and space all round:
			Reduce crown all round by 1-2 m to suitable new growing points. Thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches. Lift canopy all round by 1-2m, balance crown.
<u>Fro</u> 11	<u>nt</u> Japanese Maple	(Acer japonicum)	To contain spread and improve light to and close of the front

Reduce and reshape crown by 25-30% all round to suitable new growing points.

Thin and clean out crown and remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches. Lift and balance crown.
