Although this public house, The Elephant's Head, is just north of the boundary of our Conservation Area, our Committee felt that this advertisement for Heineken should not be allowed for the following reasons:

The public house is a good building which is remarkably intact on a prominent corner of Camden High Street and Hawley Crescent.

The lettering- 'Heineken \*' should certainly not be placed on the handsome architrave, which is surmounted by the detailed cornice.

The advertisement really spoils the integrity of this good Victorian building.
