The acoustic report is incorrect in that the nearest direct line from the proposed units to residential property is to the properties of Russell Square Mansions. The acoustic report makes no mention of the residential properties of Russell Square Mansions There were no readings taken from Russell Square Mansions. These readings would be significantly lower than the other readings were taken as much of Russell Square Mansions is very well shielded from road and other noise. The scheme proposes an acoustic screen around the plant directly adjacent to Cosmo Place only. It proposes that will protect Cosmo Place only – and this will therefore send noise directly at Russell Square Mansions, including some bedrooms that are very near. The scheme proposes that the plant on the roof on the spur of the hotel perpendicular to Cosmo Place will be unshielded, even though these are very close to bedrooms at the rear of Russell Square Mansions. On the grounds of noise nuisance, I ask that this application be rejected. Even with acoustic shielding, if this equipment is used overnight, it will be a very significant noise nuisance impacting 16 of the 21 flats in Russell Square Mansions
