Submission of Written Scheme of Investigation, to secure a programme of archaeological mitigation required by condition 5 of planning permission reference 2012/6132/P dated 30/08/2013, for Redevelopment of the site to provide 43 residential units (40 x private and 3 x affordable) within a six storey plus basement building and retention of the existing façade to Parker Street, following demolition of the existing hostel accommodation and former Aldwych Workshops on Parker Mews and associated storage, cycle parking, refuse and landscape works (Class C3).

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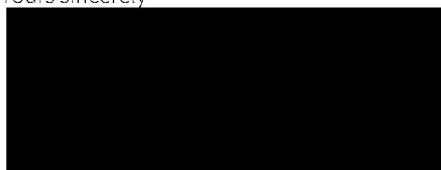
