ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

OF 22 FROGNAL WAY LONDON NW3 6XE

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, under Section 171 A (1) (a) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations. The Explanatory Note at the end of the Notice and the enclosures to which it refers contain important additional information.

2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land at: 22 FROGNAL WAY LONDON NW3 6XE

as shown, for the purposes of identification only, outlined in black on the attached plan.

3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without Planning Permission:

The removal of the original roof and fascia boards from the three wings of the dwelling house.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE:

- 1. It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last 4 years.
- 2. The alterations to the dwelling house, which include the removal of the original roof and the original fascia boards, have a detrimental impact on the appearance of the building and the character and appearance of the Hampstead Conservation Area. As such the works are contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting High Quality Places and Conserving Our



Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; policy DP24 (Securing High Quality Design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

The Council do not consider that planning permission should be given because planning conditions could not overcome these problems.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Within a period of four months of the Notice taking effect:

Completely reinstate the original roof and fascia boards to the three wings of the dwelling house.

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 26th October 2015 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

Note Pursuant to Regulation 5 of the Town and Country (Enforcement Notices and Appeals) (England) Regulations 2002

If you appeal against the notice on Ground (a) "That planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the enforcement notice, or that the condition which is alleged not to have been complied with should be discharged" there is a fee payable under Regulation 10 of the Town and Country Planning (Fees for Applications, Deemed Applications, Requests and Site Visits) (England) Regulations 2012/No.2920 for the deemed application for the planning permission for the development alleged to be in breach of planning control in the enforcement notice.

The fee is payable twice to the "London Borough of Camden", as the Local Planning Authority.

If you wish to appeal under Ground (a), the fee payable to the "London Borough of Camden" should accompany the copy of the appeal form sent to the Council at the following address:

The fee is £195.00.

- (b) Send a second copy of the appeal form and notice to the Council at:


