The whole of Gloucester Gate Mews is protected by a conservation order, in this case specifically that protecting 10 Gloucester Gate. The current plan would destroy the charm and symmetry of this historic Mews. 2. The application makes it clear that ALL building traffic for 10 Gloucester Gate would use Gloucester Gate Mews. This would mean no local traffic could access the Mews during the day, including Mews residents and Camden Rubblish and Recycling vehicles, over many months. This is unacceptable.
