T1 and T2 - Portuguese Laurel, 30% crown reduction per tree, 1 to 1.5m to be removed from each branch length. Dimensions need controlling to prevent internal shading.

T3 - Laburnum, remove deadwood and reshape crown by way of 30% crown volume removal to avoid make tree more compact. Could well be dying.
