I write regarding your submission, specifically having reviewed;

- One dimensional basement heave calculations rev 01 (Train and Kemp, February 2016)
- Correspondence re: piling, construction and station foundations (7th March 2016)

I make the following observations;

- The impact has been assessed during all construction phases for adjacent London Underground (LU) structures, and excavation has been identified as the most onerous phase.
- The predicted movements are negligible (less than 1mm heave to the crown of the platform tunnels)

I confirm on behalf of LU, that I have no objection to these ground movements, subject to the condition(s) given below;

- Appropriate monitoring of those LU assets potentially affected by your works (eg: condition surveys).
- 2. Consultation on any design change that has the potential to impact LU.
- 3. Ongoing liaison, correspondence and progress updates, including the submission of relevant method statements in due course.
