I wish to protest at what is an obvious attempt to subvert very clear planning requirements for this area. Firstly, of course the fact that the development is proposed in a long established Conservation Area. Next, the construction of the proposed dwelling will involve the removal of mature trees, themselves under a protection order.

The construction work will involve much movement of trucks to provide a totally unnecessary double depth basement which (together with HS2) will not improve the stability of the soil in the immediate area.

In conclusion I return to the most pertinent objection Conversion Orders should mean just that.
