2016/3701/P	Sandra Wheen	56 Gordon Mansions Torrington Place London WC1E 7HG	16/08/2016 12:01:01	COMMEM AIL	<p>I live in Gordon Mansions in a top floor flat overlooking the Mews and am very aware of the increasing difficulty that mews residents nearer street level are having in living with the changes of use of the public buildings in the mews.</p> <p>I oppose this change of use from office to mainly clinical use for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Foot access into the mews, particularly through the arch from Huntley Street is not particularly safe or suitable because pedestrians share a narrow access with a growing number of service vehicles.</li> <li>2. Transport conveying patients to the mews is likely to experience long delays in gaining access to the mews because of vehicle congestion at the Huntley Street access point. [There is no vehicle access into the mews from Torrington Place.]</li> <li>3. The hospital have a policy to do most of their deliveries and waste collections at night. Residents of Chenies Mews are already disturbed at intervals throughout the night by waste collection vehicles backing along the mews from Torrington Place (a situation that urgently needs changing). To add to their number would only compound this problem.</li> <li>4. If Planning Permission is granted servicing hours should be restricted to 8am to 6pm to protect the amenity of mews residents.</li> </ol>
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
