The Northern boundary wall to St Georges Gardens is a 9" thick red and yellow stock brick wall stepped in height ranging from 2.8m to 2.18m. The wall has 705mm square piers at approximately 4.4m intervals along the length of the wall. It is proposed to demolish and rebuild 2 No. brick panels and 1 No. brick pier. There have been several repairs to this section of wall in the past.
