Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Large Chestnut T1 - Reduce crown by 2-3 metres and reshape.

- 1 x Small Laurel T2 Reduce overall crown by 1- 2 metres to form a more balanced crown.
- 1 x Small Hawthorn T3 Lightly reduce crown by 0.5 1 metres and reshape.
- 1 x Medium Purple Plum T4 Reduce overall crown by 1-2 metres and reshape.
- 1 x Small Sliver Birch T5 Reduce overall crown by 1-2 metres and reshape.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 15 June 2016 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these

- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
