I would like to register my strong objections to the planning application, on the grounds that this is a significant increase in office space that will inevitably lead to even greater volumes of activity at the waste recycling facility in Mornington Crescent and to an even greater number of movements of heavy goods vehicles to the loading bay at the rear of the building. This is already exceeding the limits of what is acceptable to residents in Mornington Crescent. Any casual monitoring of the rear entrance to the site will show HGVs reversing, double-parking and slamming doors, large delivery vans left with their engines idling and radios blaring, and generating levels of noise that are a statutory nuisance. Greater London House is the source of considerable noise nuisance in the residential area of Mornington Crescent and causing continuing detriment to the amenity and well-being of local residents. The recycling site is dominating the life of the crescent and the proposed increase in office space will worsen all these problems, which are already completely unacceptable in a residential area.

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
