Refurbishment of 6 doors in the Grade 1 Wilkins Building. The proposed scope of works include the following: 1. All doorsets will be temporary removed offsite to allow refurbishment, repairs and re-varnishing. The existing brass pull handles and brass escutcheons, will be rehung. 2. The kicker plates will be replaced with ones that match the existing height, width and thickness 3. The existing floor embed door closure operation will be permanently disused. The brass floor plate will be left in place. A new brass overhead door closure will be installed. 4. Fire rating improvements: - o Install intumescent strips around the doors. o Install
