Reasons for Refusal

The dormer window, due to its size, location and detailed design detracts from the appearance of the host building and the character and appearance of the Hampstead Conservation Area and is contrary to Camden Core Strategy Policy CS14 and Camden Development Policies DP24 & DP25.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
