Thanks Matthias. I don't think the plans are completely clear but on the basis that it's a direct replacement for the existing kiosk, in the same location, then we have no objections subject to the following conditions being imposed:

- The intensity of the illumination of the sign shall not exceed 600cd/m;
- The sign shall not display any moving, or apparently moving, images;
- The display shall not change more than once every 10 seconds;
- Any sequential change between advertisements will take place over a period no greater than one second.

However, I do also acknowledge that Camden are the highway authority for Kingsway and that the acceptability of the proposals in respect of public safety will ultimately be determined by your transport department.
