We the undersigned have been informed by the Covent Garden Community Association that Travelodge Hotel, 10 Drury Lane, which is situated directly opposite our residence have applied to have permission to provide table and chairs on the concourse/podium outside the hotel where drinking will be permitted. We had no notification from Camden about this application despite the fact that the Travelodge Hotel is directly opposite our homes. Why?
