I am very familiar with this late Georgian terrace that lies in the heart of KentishTown and is one of the jewels in its diverse mix of architectural styles. I am concerned by inaccuracies in the application whereby 29 Leighton Road is described as 'late-Victorian', when the terrace was built in 1828. Furthermore it forms part of a Conservation Area which should be protected in its entirety. The attempt to claim a precedent for mansard roofs in the road is misleading, as the houses referred to are much later houses of a different design and situated further along the road. This house is not a 'single family home', as claimed, but a building rented out to a series of lodgers or tenants. I fully support the arguments presented by well-informed neighbours, who are concerned to protect the homogenous appearance of this historic terrace.
