1.0 INTRODUCTION

Cholmley Gardens is a residential block of 164 flats in West Hampstead built in the 1920s.

De Metz Forbes Knight Architects (dMFK) have been commissioned to provide architectural services to replace the 22 entrance doors, as well as replacing the wall lights and signage.

This proposal aims to:

- 1- Replace the existing entrance doors.
- 2- Replace existing wall light with up/down light on either side of each door.
- Replace the existing signage.

2.0 PROPOSED SCHEME

There are 22 entrance doors with 4 different types of entrances. The existing doors are metal framed double leaf, majority glazed with bronze finish. The signage is located either above or on the left side of the door. There is a wall light with a number of the apartments on, located either above or on the left side of the door.

2.0 PROPOSED SCHEME

The proposal includes replacing the existing doors, together with the signage and wall lights.

Most of the proposed doors will open inwards, except in cases where there are steps and understair cupboard inside the building which does not allow the door to fully open as it hits either the step or the understair. The doors will be painted black gloss hardwood single leaf with recessed panels. The handle, kick panel and hinges will be brushed chrome.

New stand-off signage letters are proposed above each door with a white painted render band added where the existing entrance is entirely brick (entrance type 4).

The existing wall light will be replaced by 2 discrete up/down lights on either side of each entrance to illuminate the door area.
