## Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended) NOTIFICATION OF AN APPEAL

The Council has been notified of an appeal against an enforcement notice which has been made to the Planning Inspectorate.

The appeal concerns property at:

45 Goldhurst Terrace London NW6 3HB

and the breach of planning control alleged in the enforcement notice is:

Erection of a rear dormer, side dormer and rear roof terrace materially different from approved plans so as to be without planning permission;

Removal of the clay tile roof to the projecting bay at rear first floor level and creation of a brick balustrade to create an external balcony;

Installation of a uPVC door installed at ground floor rear within the bay;

Replacement of the timber-framed windows to the first and second floor rear elevation with uPVC windows.

Grounds of Appeal

The appellant/s have appealed on the following grounds:

a) That planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the notice.
