If Amelanchier spp Front left Juvenile tree. To maintain the tree, the suggested works are: To lightly prune all round by 0.5 - 0.75m, crown lift all round to 3m above ground.  If Common Crab Apple whiteb Front right Mature tree. This tree is diseased with blossom wilt/wither tip. This causes the leaves to wilt and die off. It is mainly aesthetic. The tree has several decaying cavities and it is being shaded out by the neighbours Sycamore tree. The tree has outgrown its location. The suggested works are: To fell to ground level by sectional takedown.  If Cherry Prunus spp Rear right Mature tree. This tree is in close proximity to the property. There are numerous patches of bleeding canker throughout the crown and a large decaying wound on the trunk. The suggested works are: To fell to ground level by sectional takedown.						

T5 Sycamore Acer pseudoplatanus Rear boundary, righthand corner Mature, twin stemmed tree. This tree has been damaged by a bonfire some years ago. The resulting wound has decayed extensively. To lessen the mechanical loading on the compromised stems, the suggested works are:

T4 London Plane Platanus x hispanica Rear right Large, mature, widespreading tree. This tree is starting to outgrow its location. It is overshadowing other trees and blocking light. To maximise the light, reduce the moisture uptake and maintain the tree, the suggested works are: To reduce the overall height

and the lateral spread all round by 2.5 - 3m, thin through the crown by 5%, crown lift to 4.5m above ground, remove dedwood.

To fell to ground level by sectional takedown. T6 Sycamore Acer pseudoplatanus Rear boundary, lefthand corner Remove dead wood only. T7 Ash Fraxinus excelsior Rear centre Large, mature, leaning tree. The tree is leaning because it is being suppressed by the other trees so it has grown for where the light is. There is substantial reaction wood formation on the main stem. To reduce the lever arm and mechanical loading, the suggested works are: To reduce the height and the lateral spread all round by 2 - 2.5m, clean out crown, remove deadwood.
