The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission

## Informative(s):

Details submitted include a planting scheme, paving and seating plan, drainage system and maintenance plan. The details have been assessed by the Tree and landscaping Officer and considered to be of high quality and to enhance the biodiversity of the area; the maintenance plan is considered sufficient to demonstrate that the green wall will be adequately maintained.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The



proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host buildings and streetscene, on the character of the conservation area or on neighbouring amenity.
